Trafford Alternative Education Provision is a Pupil Referral Unit providing bespoke education placements for: permanently excluded students: students at risk of permanent exclusion: students with diagnosed SEND: students with EHCP outlining Social, Emotional and Mental-ill health and students with physical health needs. We have a much smaller cohort compared to mainstream schools

At Trafford Alternative Education Provision we offer a bespoke curriculum that caters to the individual requirements of our students. Ultimately, we are a short stay school with the majority of students either returning to: their home school (TMES and STEP OUT) a new mainstream school or specialist educational provision

Our student population is fluid and we often receive Year 10 students partway through their GCSEs. For continuity of education, some students may go on to complete their final Year 11 at TAEP if deemed an appropriate placement.

Year on year we have increased our GCSE offer. However, we do not offer the necessary recognised qualifications to achieve the English Baccalaureate or Progress 8 and Attainment 8 scores.

For these reasons, it is not practical to make performance comparisons of TAEP students against national data
