8th June - Park Life Heaton Park - "Build a stage."

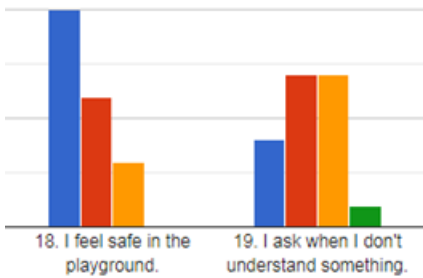

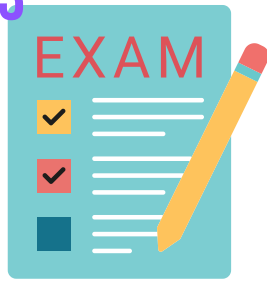

The best part of your job? The students having a good time.

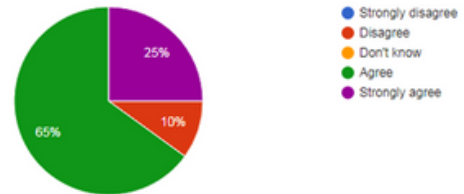
What do you do after work? Children, gym and relax.

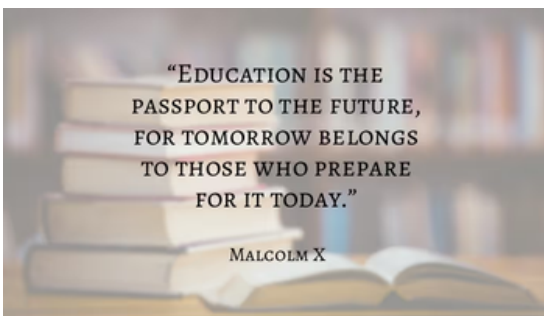

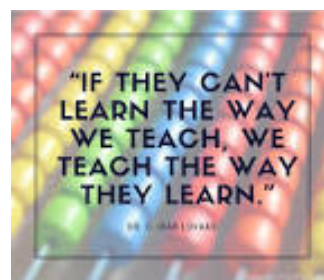
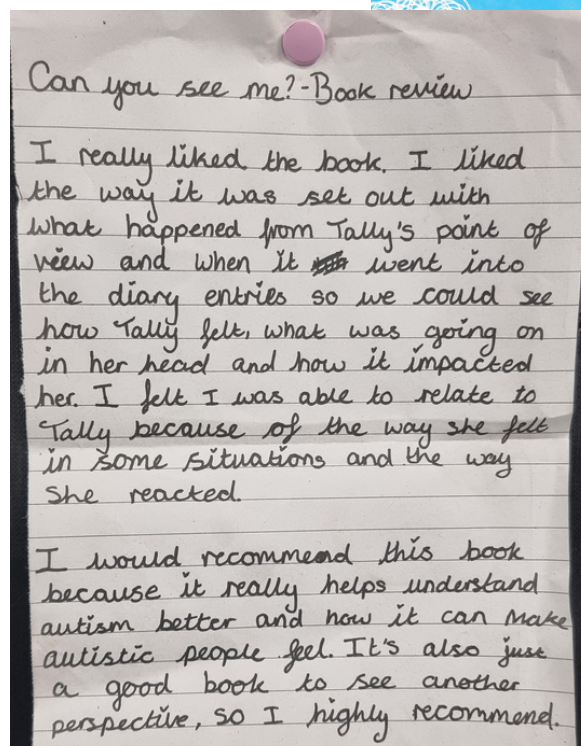
