



## STEP OUT INTERVENTION



### Target Students

The programme primarily focuses on students who are at risk of exclusion, often due to undiagnosed Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND). These students may struggle with academic, emotional, or behavioural challenges that could lead to a permanent exclusion from school.

### Goal of Reintegration

The core objective of STEP OUT is to help students reintegrate back into their home school in the short to medium term. This is particularly important at Key Stage 3 (KS3) and the early years of Key Stage 4 (Year 10), which are critical stages in a student's academic development.

### Support Strategy

STEP OUT acts as a bridging programme, offering a mix of emotional, academic, and behavioural support. The aim is to address underlying challenges and help the student manage difficulties in a way that prepares them to transition back to their home school successfully.

### Prevention of Permanent Exclusion

By providing tailored interventions and continuous support, the STEP OUT programme strives to prevent permanent exclusion, keeping students engaged in their education and on track for academic and social and emotional success.
